

## SNA NH Plan of Action for 09/10 +

- House of Delegates will be voting on re-imagining, of SNA, by removing foodservice from its documents and replacing it with School Nutrition. We suggest we do the same at the local level
- Reauthorization 09 will be introducing mandatory education for School Nutrition Personnel at all levels
- Our Suggested Local SNA NH (**5 year plan**) that was drawn up at Leadership, with Donna and Jeanne, and discussed with Joyce and Harlene
- **For SNA NH to become the local professional resource center for all School Nutrition related information**
- Restructure Education
  - Restructure our Education Program, within the Association, by appointing a new Professional Growth Chair Committee. The committee will consist of: Jeanette Kimball and Cheri White. Jeanette and Cheri will work directly with our Regional Directors, Mary Borg and Phil Dallon, to develop the whole 09/10 year of meetings, workshops, and conferences
    - Professional Fall Conference and Installation of Officers (all set)
    - Core Classes of Healthy Edge and Sanitation to be offered at least once in each region
    - Regional Meetings based on Key Areas affiliated with certification
    - Professional Spring Conference based on Key Areas
  - Promote District Owned Membership
    - Mark Joyce, Executive Director of Administrators
    - Invitation to develop and present an outline that informs our administrators of the benefits of our association
    - If approved, in July, we will present Sept 24<sup>th</sup> to local NH Business Administrators (ASBO) as a one hour key note presentation. We will then follow up and make appointments to speak at the Superintendents Conference and the Principals Administration Meeting
    - We currently have legislation that states School Nutrition Directors “**should** be” affiliated with a professional group like SNA, language should be rewritten to state “**must** be” affiliated
  - Develop and Promote Awards and Recognitions at local level
  - Proctor SNS Exam
- Review Conference Locations
  - Bill Janson will be responsible for locating and reserving future sites for conferences and workshops. Bill will research available schools, tech programs, and colleges like SNU, in order to become more cost effective and forward the savings on to our members to encourage participation
  - Bill Janson will work in conjunction with Barbara Schultz in coordinating our yearly vendor show
- Develop our PP&L Chair with Dave Dziki mentoring Tracey Dube
- Establish a Media Chair that will be responsible for communications via: email, mailings, and our website
